

DESMUKE

This small, shoulderless, lozenge-shaped point has a characteristic contraction from the lower part of the body toward the base. The maximum width of *Desmuke* is in the basal one-third of the point. The lateral edges are often alternately beveled and may be serrated.



Distribution: Primarily south Texas. **Period:** Late Archaic. **Sites:** Oulline; La Perdida; San Miguel Creek sites; Duval County (41DV1,2,3)
