## **PANDORA**

This elongate, triangular point has an unstemmed, straight base and is relatively large and crudely chipped. It is possible that some are actually preforms or were used for knives.



Distribution: Widely distributed from south Texas and the lower Pecos across central Texas./Period: Middle to Late Archaic./Sites: Wheeler; Morhiss; Johnston-Heller; La Perdida
