
## Stone Artifacts of Texas Indians

## REFUGIO

This unstemmed, elongate-triangular point sometimes has a needlelike distal tip. The base is convex and often thinned. Like *Kinney* and *Pandora*, it is possible that some, or most, are actually preforms or knives.



Distribution: Reported in south Texas, the central coast and the lower Pecos./Period: Archaic./Sites: Choke Canyon; La Perdida; San Miguel Creek (41AT7); McMullen County
